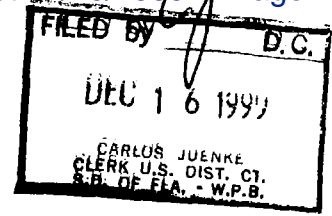

ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

THIS CAUSE is before the court upon its own motion. Rule 41.1 of the Local Rules of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida provides that


Civil actions not at issue which have been pending without any proceedings having been taken therein for more than three months may be dismissed for want of prosecution by the Court on its own motion after notice to counsel of record. Such actions may also be dismissed for want of prosecution at any time on motion by any party upon notice to the other parties.

See also Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b) (dismissal upon motion by defendant for lack of prosecution). Review of the record in this case indicates that the only request in plaintiff's complaint was the issuance of a subpoena, and the subpoena was issued as requested. Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED and ADJUDGED

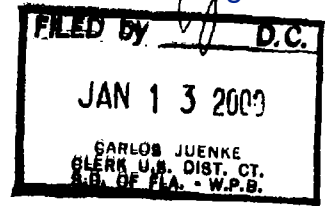
